Anti-social parking

We are fortunate to be located in the heart of a charming village. However, we have recently had a number of concerns from local residents about inconsiderate parking during drop-off and pick-up times.

We kindly ask all parents and carers to park safely and responsibly. Please avoid blocking driveways, obstructing pavements, or parking in ways that make it difficult for other vehicles to pass. It's essential that emergency vehicles can pass through and residents can access their properties at all times. Villagers take great care and pride in

their environment. It is essential parents/carers do not drive across or churn up grass verges.

We also encourage everyone to be respectful towards our neighbours and other road users. A friendly wave or a moment of patience goes a long way in maintaining positive relationships with the wider community.

If you are able to, consider walking part of the way to school or using alternative parking further from the gates; not only does this reduce congestion, but it also promotes healthy habits for our children. We have the option of parking at the Blackboys Inn, particularly at drop off, plus the village hall car park is readily available.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. By working together, we can ensure that our school remains a valued part of the village and that everyone feels respected and safe.

Online Behaviour

As technology becomes a bigger part of our children's lives, we need to work together to ensure their online experiences are positive and safe. Many of our older children now use mobile phones or other devices to connect with friends, but it's important to remind them about using these responsibly.

We encourage all parents to regularly monitor their child's online activity, including the apps and platforms they use, to help protect them from risks such as inappropriate content or online bullying. A simple conversation about online safety can go a long way. Please also remind your child of the power of kind words. Whether in person or online, being thoughtful and respectful can make a big difference in creating a positive environment for everyone. Let's teach our children to think before they post and to always treat others as they would like to be treated.
